

Iroquoia Bruce Trail Club

A 175m reroute of the Main Trail in the Crawford Lake Conservation Area, completed 21 June 2009.

The Main Trail now turns right off the Conservation Area roadway into a wooded area approximately 550 meters from Guelph Line (rather than the previous 800 meters). After turning off the roadway, the trail immediately crosses a boardwalk, passing a rock outcrop and emerges into a grassed area prior to rejoining the Main Trail.

The Crawford Lake Side Trail is extended by approximately 250m to a junction with the Main Trail where the Main Trail now turns off the roadway.

Main Trail closed - 790m; Main Trail added - 175m; Side Trail added – 250m (approximately).

Temporary trail change notices have been posted at each end of the reroute; all blazing has been changed.
